


How to start using the tachograph.online service?

The basic version of the service is designed for small carriers. Evaluating data from a driver card (DDD file) allows you to generate an overview of working hours, driving times, and rest periods at a fraction of the cost compared to competing solutions. The service also offers direct downloading of data from the tachograph and driver card using a download cable that you connect to the tachograph and your mobile phone. There is no need to purchase expensive download devices.

For larger companies, an individual price can be arranged, or the carrier can integrate the evaluation into their own fleet solution using the DDDLab API.

The first step is registration. Completing registration requires entering an activation code, which you will receive at the email address provided during registration.

After logging in, you will arrive at the home page - the Dashboard.

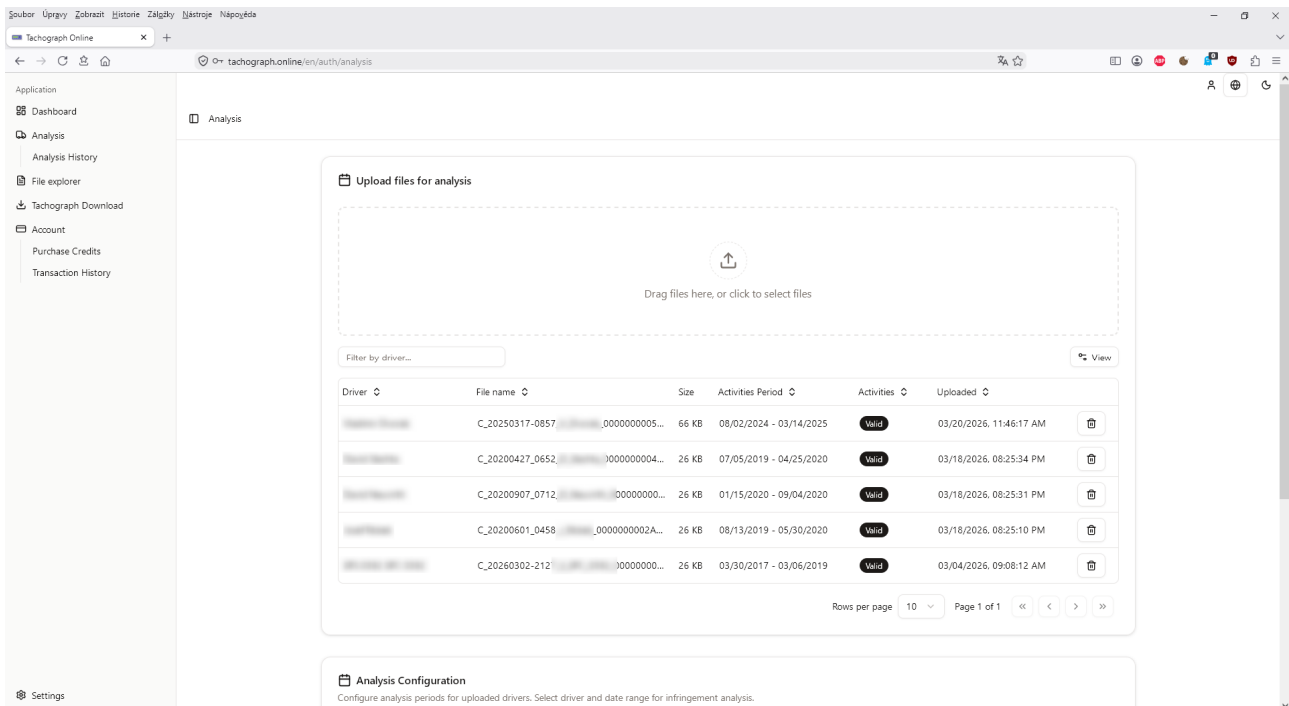

Here you can see your current credit balance, which you can use for analysis, as well as the most recent analyses and evaluations of DDD files.

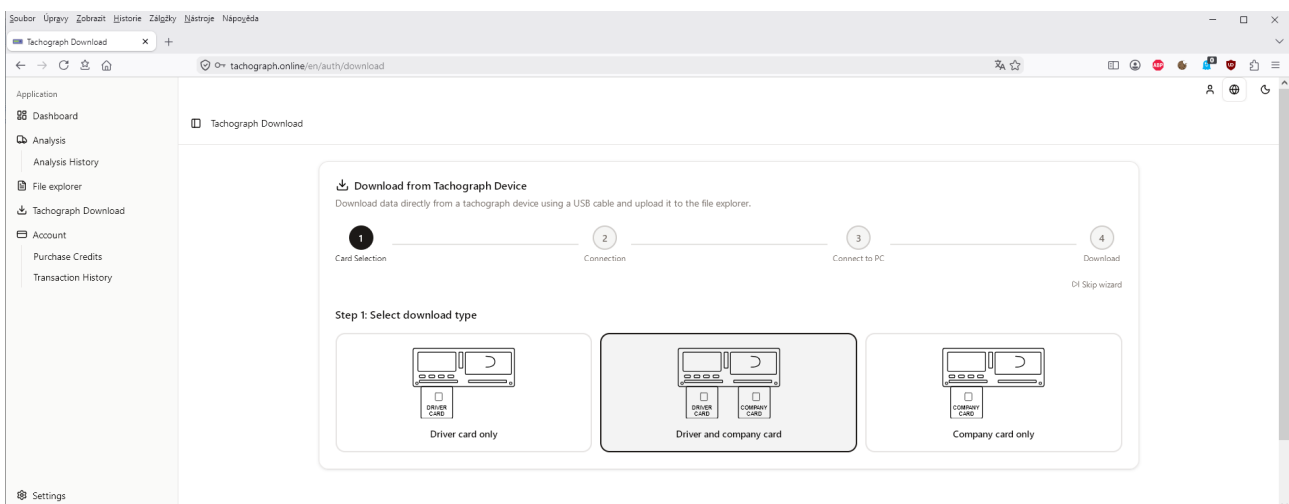
A data viewer is available free of charge. It only displays data stored in the file downloaded from the driver card - this is raw data without violation checks or calculation of driving times, rest periods, etc. If you want to evaluate the data, you must purchase credits.

The minimum amount for which credits can be purchased is 100 credits at a price of 4 € (excl. VAT). This is possible via a payment gateway using a payment card. Another option is a subscription, which is intended more for companies with multiple vehicles. The subscription offers the best price per credit. However, it should be noted that credits from a subscription are not transferable to the following month. More information can be found in the "General Terms and Conditions" document for this service.

If you have credit, you can upload data and start an analysis. On the analysis page, DDD (or ESM) files can be dragged from File Explorer directly onto the file upload area. You can drag multiple selected files from multiple drivers at once. Clicking on the drop area will open a file upload window.



It is also possible to upload files directly to the portal from the tachograph using the Tacho Web Download cable. This is also possible using an Android phone. The driver or dispatcher can download the files from the tachograph to the portal via a mobile browser, and they can then be evaluated on a computer.




The next step is configuring the analysis. For the driver whose data you want to evaluate (whose files are uploaded to the portal), you need to select the period for which the analysis is to be performed. A calendar is used for this purpose. Days on which activity was found are outlined in green in the calendar. The selected range is also highlighted in green. The left side of the calendar is used to select the start date of the analysis, and the right side for the last day. Quick selection options are also available for choosing various recent time periods, such as the last month.



Example of a calendar - the first available data in the file downloaded from the card is from August 2024, the last from March 2025.

Once the required analyses have been added, the analysis can be started. The page displays the cost of the analysis in credits. Once the analysis is complete, reports can either be downloaded to a PC or simply viewed in the web browser.

Example of adding one configuration - this covers the entire month of January, the cost is 31 credits. The analysis will be launched and reports generated after pressing the button highlighted in red on the right side.

Analysis data is stored on the server for a limited period, but for a minimum of 30 days. Please note that the service is not intended for data backup, but only for analysis

By pressing the "Attestation" button, it is also possible to generate an "Attestation of activities" document.

For invoicing purchased credits, billing details must be correctly filled in. This can be done by clicking the **Settings** button in the lower-left corner of the page. After clicking on Settings, the left menu will change. Options are then available not only for setting billing details but also for changing the password, cancelling a subscription, and similar actions. It is also possible to configure night working hours here.
